Highlights of The Tour

Ancient Site Phaselis;

The town was set up by the Rhodians in 700 BC. Because of its location on an isthmus separating two harbours, it became the most important harbour city of the western Lycia and an important centre of commerce between Greece, Asia, Egypt, and Phoenicia. Phaselis has three harbours: the 'Northern Harbour', the 'Battle Harbour' and the 'Protected (Sun) Harbour', of which the last is the most important today. A 24-



metre-wide ancient street runs through the middle of the city. The 'Hadrian Waterway Gate' is



on the southern part of the street. There are ruins of shops and stores on the sides of the street and near these are ruins of public places such as Roman baths, agoras and theatres. These structures are dated to the 2nd century BC. There are water canals between

the town centre and the 70 m plateau. There are also numerous sarcophagi.

Boat Trip; You'll have the chance to discover neighbouring bays and ancient coast sites in Kemer.
